

God wants you to talk to Him about everything. Nothing is too big or too small.



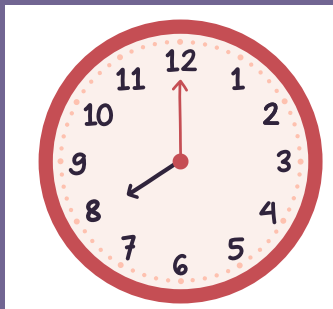
Should I pray aloud?

God hears you whether you pray aloud or silently. Praying aloud helps you stay focused. God hears all of your prayers no matter what!



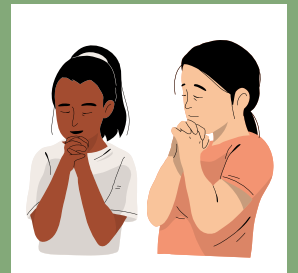
How long should my prayer last?

You can pray for one second or for hours. God is always listening!



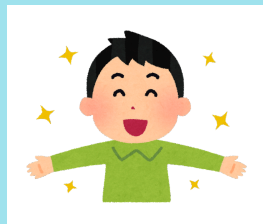
Can I pray with my friends?

ABSOLUTELY! Praying with your friends will make your faith and your friendship stronger.



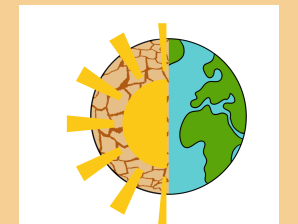
Should I always fold my hands?
